Dear parents and guardians

This year the Department of Education have given schools a grant towards the purchase of workbooks and books for children's learning. Books for your child will be available in school in September. The books won't belong to you – they belong to the school.

Over the summer you will be getting your child ready for return to school on August 30th.

Here are items you should buy:

All children should wear their **school uniform** every day. Uniforms can be bought in Dunnes, Tesco's, Marks and Spencers etc. They wear their **school tracksuit** on PE day. The tracksuit is available in Gillespie Sports.

All children should have a **school bag**. Your child should be able to lift and carry their bag. The bag should be long enough to fit a workbook.

Children should have their own **pencil case** for their pencils, colours etc

Here is what each class needs:

2nd and 3rd class: 2 Triangular Pencils

1 Rubber/1 sharpener (for a Triangular Pencil)/30 cm ruler

1 medium size Pritt Stick Pack of Twistable Crayons

4th class: 2 pencils, 1 rubber/1 pencil sharpener

2 red pens and 2 blue pens 30 cm ruler

1 medium size Pritt Stick Pack of Twistable Crayons

5th and 6th: 2 pencils, 2 red pens, 2 blue pens.

1 rubber/1 sharpener 30 cm ruler

One medium size Pritt Stick Pack of Twistable Crayons

One Maths Set (box containing small ruler/protractor etc)
