School tracksuits can be purchased in Gillespie Sport, Tubbercurry. School tracksuits are worn on PE days and for trips.

We have coats and jumpers that have been left behind since last term. If your child has lost a coat or a jumper, please contact the school office. All unclaimed clothes will be given to the charity shop in October. Since Covid we do not store old tracksuits or uniforms or site. We encourage parents to give old uniforms to Vincent's Shop in Tubbercurry.
