- School opens on Monday November 1st for all pupils. <u>Pupils must bring a signed</u> <u>Return to School Form.</u>
- Your child's class teacher will meet them at the front of the school on Monday morning to collect the return to school forms.
- Return to School Forms were sent home with all children before the midterm break. Return to School Forms may also be downloaded from our website.
- When you sign the Return to School Form you are letting us know that you believe your child is safe to return to school and is not unwell.
- Children who have been told to isolate or who have symptoms of Covid 19 should not attend school.
- Symptoms of Covid 19 are fever, cough, tiredness, loss of taste or smell. Other symptoms are sore throat, headache, aches and pains, diarrhoea, skin rash, red or irritated eyes.
