Dear parents and guardians,

We are almost at the end of term 1. Thank you all for your help and support over the term. The following are a number of notes for your attention.

- Parent Teacher meetings continue this week. Please make sure that we have an up to date phone number for you. If you missed your appointment please contact the school for a new appointment.

All meetings with are staff are by appointment. Teachers have a class to teach during the day and are unavailable to meet during class time. If you need to talk to a teacher please contact the school office for an appointment.

- Thanks to everyone who came to the **Parents' Association AGM**. The PA have done great work supporting the school for many years. They are having a fund-raising raffle before Christmas. Tickets will be on sale in school. The money raised by the PA will be used in the school – inviting Santa to visit or the Easter bunny and organising a party for the First Communion class.
- December 8th is a Church Holy Day. Children from 2nd – 6th will attend 9.30 mass on that day. Children of different faiths may stay behind in the school.
